SENTENCING MEMORANDUM

On February 22, 2022, defendant David Unitan will come before this Court for sentencing on one count of wire fraud in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1343, one count of aggravated identity theft in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1028(A), and one count of money laundering in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1957.

At sentencing pursuant to a plea agreement with the government, and based on other materials provided to the Court, Mr. Unitan will respectfully ask the Court to impose a total sentence of imprisonment of 44 months, followed by three years of supervised, and restitution as agreed upon by the parties.

This sentence is “sufficient, but not greater than necessary, to comply with the purposes set forth” in 18 U.S.C. § 3553(a)(2). *United States v. Carty*, 520 F.3d 984, 991 (9th Cir. 2008) (“The overarching statutory charge for a district court is to ‘impose a sentence sufficient, but not greater than necessary’ to reflect the seriousness of the offense, promote respect for the law, and provide just punishment; to afford adequate deterrence; to protect the public; and to provide the defendant with needed educational or vocational training, medical care, or other correctional treatment.”).
