ORDER OF DETENTION

THIS CAUSE coming to be heard upon the government's motion to revoke the order of release and detain defendant Crystal Lundberg, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3148, and this Court having considered written and oral argument on this matter, the Court hereby finds:

1. There is probable cause to believe that Defendant Crystal Lundberg committed a federal crime while on supervised release in this matter, namely, a violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1343, 1014, and 1001.

2. Defendant is unlikely to abide by any condition of release or combination of conditions of release.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3148, that defendant CRYSTAL LUNDBERG be detained to begin serving the sentence of imprisonment imposed in this case.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon order of the United States District Court or on request of an attorney of the government, the Warden shall deliver defendant to a United States Marshal for the purpose of an appearance in connection with a court proceeding.
