The United States Attorney charges:

COUNT ONE
(False Statement to Small Business Administration)

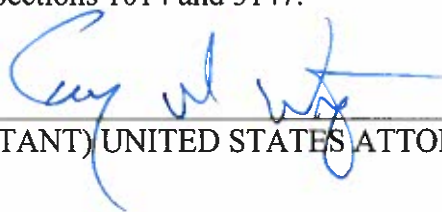
On about April 7, 2020, in the District of Maine, the defendant,

JOHN J. CAVANAUGH, JR.,

knowingly made false statements and reports for the purpose of influencing the action of the Small Business Administration, in connection with an application, commitment and loan. Specifically, **CAVANAUGH** claimed in an application for an Economic Injury Disaster Loan that he was not presently subject to an indictment.

CAVANAUGH committed this offense while he was on release pursuant to an order dated March 5, 2019, from the United States District Court for the District of Maine, in *United States v. John J. Cavanaugh, Jr.*, Case No. 2:19-cr-00131-NT. The order, which was issued under Title 18, United States Code, Section 3142(c), notified **CAVANAUGH** of the potential effect of committing an offense while on pretrial release.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1014 and 3147.
